/b/ Under the provisions of Public Law 426, approved by the 83rd Congress on June 24, 1954, these lands are declared to be revested O&C railroad grant lands. They were placed under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of Agriculture to be administered with National Forest lands, with all revenues derived from such lands to be handled in accordance with the provisions of Title II of the O&C Act of August 28, 1937 (50 Stat. 874) as amended by Public Law 426.
