Subject: Funding for Potentially Responsible Party (PRP)
Searches

The National Applied Resource Sciences Center (NARSC) received funding in the FY 1997 AWP for PRP Searches.

As directed by the AWP, these funds are available on a 50 percent cost-sharing basis to be matched with funds from field offices requesting these services.

A number of PRP search projects have been scheduled for field offices who have requested this service in FYs 1996 and 1997. We have funding available to assist with four additional PRPs. We estimate that a PRP search will cost \$14,000 (\$7,000 - field office/\$7,000 - NARSC). Please submit your requests for PRP search projects to me in writing at the above address. Include a charge code to which NARSC will charge your share of the cost of the project with your request. We will accept requests to the extent funds are available, and we will schedule completion dates sequentially. Some projects may not be completed until subsequent fiscal years, although the funds will be obligated in FY 1997.
