This IB is being reissued with a change to extend the nomination due date to November 24, 1999 for the Pathways course scheduled for February 7-11, 2000.

The following information is provided to announce that nominations are being accepted to attend Pathways training course 1400-08, for FY2000.

Pathways training is a one week course targeted at BLM employees having 3-5 years of service with the BLM. The course, which is taught at the National Training Center (NTC), is designed for the participants to:

- gain a bureauwide perspective of the organizational culture and key issues;
- develop and maintain strong interpersonal working relationships throughout the agency;
- develop an appreciation of the individuals and the need for a supportive work environment;
- develop a stronger sense of community throughout the BLM.

There are no tuition costs, however, the attendee's assigned Center will be responsible for travel and per diem. Employees must obtain supervisory approval prior to registering for this course.

The two Pathways courses currently scheduled are on the following dates:

- **February 7-11, 2000 (nominations are due to the NTC by November 29, 1999)**

- May 15-19, 2000 (nominations are due to the NTC by February 15, 2000)
