The Nevada State Office will be hosting the FY 2003 Noxious Weed Workshop in Ely, Nevada beginning at 8:00 am on March 4 and concluding on March 6, 2003. Bob Wilson, University of Nevada Cooperative Extension Specialist, will address the participants on March 5 regarding the Tri-county Weed Control model being used by the Ely Field Office to enhance their weed management program. A field trip is also planned for that day. The remainder of the workshop will be devoted to statewide coordination of weed inventory, treatment, and monitoring efforts.

The workshop is intended for the Field Office Weed Coordinators in Nevada, and the Eagle Lake and Surprise Field Offices in California. Representatives from management are also invited to attend.
