Subject: New Enhanced Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Website

We are excited to announce the unveiling of the new enhanced Wyoming Oil and Gas Commission (WOGCC) Website. The website address is <http://wogcc.state.wy.us>. The Wyoming State Office (WSO)-Reservoir Management Group (RMG) has worked hand in hand with the WOGCC to supplement their website with BLM data. The website is data rich and will help the BLM do minerals related work by providing easy access to data concerning among other things:

1. Scanned Well Logs
2. LR2000 Federal leases
3. Fee and State wells
4. Official BLM plats
5. Spacing orders
6. Federal unit agreements
7. Communitization agreements

Additionally, the WOGCC website contains an internet map server which is designed to show many aspects of minerals on Federal, State and Fee lands.


The WOGCC and WSO-RMG are planning to host a demonstration of the enhanced WOGCC website. The specifics of the demonstration are as follows:

- **The demonstration will be held on Wednesday, May 26, 2004.**
- The demonstration will be a one (1) day event: Will start at 10 am and will end about 2:30 pm.
- The new WOGCC facility in Casper will be used for the demonstration. The new address for the WOGCC is 2211 King Blvd. (see map below)
- If there is further interest in hands on training once the demonstration is over, we can make future plans for a training session at the WSO computer training room.
- In addition to demonstrating access to the data on the website, we will also discuss:
 - The present website work being done on communitization agreements,
 - Plans for more data on Federal unit agreements, and
 - WOGCC website plans for more data such as coal, water, etc.
